The bar study access pass is valid from May 22<sup>rd</sup> – July 27<sup>th</sup>.</p> <p>- Access hours to the law library will be:  Monday – Sunday: 8 am–10 pm.</p> <p>Wireless access will be available.</p> <p>- Proof that the applicant is registered to take the July 2017 bar exam must be presented at the time of purchase. However, bar studiers will have access to common reading areas within the law library.)</p>	<p><b>Free access will continue to be available for all Fordham Law School and Fordham University graduates, with Fordham student ID or Fordham Alumni Association card.</b></p> <p>Access to bar studiers who are not graduates of Fordham University or Fordham Law School will be granted under the following conditions:</p> <p>- You must be taking a bar review course at Fordham Law School.</p> <p>- 50 bar study passes will be sold for \$50 each on a first come first served basis.</p> <p>- Bar study passes permits access to library from May 23, 2017 through July 27, 2017.</p> <p>- You must appear in person to purchase a bar pass (one pass per person).</p> <p>- The first day of sale will be Tuesday, May 23<sup>rd</sup> at 8:00 am at the Reference Desk in the Maloney Library (5th floor).</p> <p>- There are no advance reservations taken for the passes.</p> <p>- Payment must be in the form of a check or money order. We <b>cannot</b> accept credit cards or cash.</p> <p>- Make checks &amp; money orders payable to the Fordham Law School Library.</p> <p>Those wishing to obtain a pass should have the following <b>two (2) forms of ID:</b></p> <p>- Law School ID, Driver's License or Passport - Proof that they are taking the July 2017 Bar Exam (bar review ID or letter from Bar Examiners are acceptable as proof of bar study). <p>Free 24/7 access for Spring, 2017 Hofstra Law graduates.</p> <p>Non-Hofstra Law graduates who are taking a bar review course at Hofstra Law in preparation for a summer or winter bar exam must purchase passes for bar study access.</p> <p>Passes are available at the Circulation Desk, and individuals must present their bar review course ID and proof of identity at the time of purchase. Bar Study Passes are not transferable, and the Library reserves the right to limit the number of passes it makes available for sale. Bar passes permit access from May 16, 2017 – July 27, 2017.</p> <p>Each Bar Study Pass is \$50 and provides access from the time of purchase. Payment can be in cash or by check made payable to “Hofstra University.”</p> <p>The pass entitles the individual to use the facilities of the Hofstra Law Library with the exception of use of the study rooms. No borrowing privileges are granted or included in the pass.</p> <p>The pass does not allow 24/7 access to the Library; it is only good for when the Library is open and the Circulation Desk is staffed. View the Library’s hours.</p> <p>Bar study access for non-Hofstra Law School graduates is a courtesy extended by the Library. Passes go on sale beginning on Friday, May 19, 2017. Passes are sold during staffed reference hours only. Library staffing schedules and hours of operation are posted to our website:  <a href="http://www.nyls.edu/library">http://www.nyls.edu/library</a>.</p> <p>Proof of law school affiliation must be presented at time of purchase. Supplies are limited, first-come, first-served.</p> <p>The charge for the Reader’s Pass is \$50, except for graduates of law schools that charge NYLS graduates more than \$50 for bar study access to their libraries. In those cases, the Reader’s Pass charge is equal to the amount that their law school charges. Payment is by cash or check only; credit cards are not accepted.</p> <p><b><i>The NYLS Reader’s Pass charge is non-refundable; lost or stolen passes will not be replaced.</i></b></p> <p>For students enrolled in the BarBri course held at NYLS, Library access is included in the registration fee. The application can be sent via e-mail to <a href="#">the Law Library</a>.</li> <li>• An access card will be issued at no charge to students preparing for the bar examination who attended a law school with a reciprocity-access agreement with St. John's, upon presentation of law school identification and a letter of introduction from their law school library indicating that they are a recent graduate.</li> <li>• Click <a href="#">HERE</a> to see a list of local law schools that offer reciprocal access.</li> <li>• An access card will be issued at no charge to students preparing for the bar examination with presentation of a current Bar Review Course ID.</li> <li>• Patrons with these access cards may use the library collections but have no borrowing privileges.</li> <li>• No access cards may be used during any exam period.</li> <li>• Access cards do not include access to the Computer Lab, on-campus parking, or access to subscription-based databases. For computer access questions, contact the Law School IT Department at (718) 990-1430. For on-campus parking questions, contact Public Safety's Parking Office at (718) 990-5561.</li> <li>• You must supply your own password if you wish to use Lexis/Nexis or Westlaw. We are contractually prohibited from issuing passwords to anyone who is NOT a currently-enrolled student.</li> </ul> <p>Public access terminals are provided on each floor for access to the Law Library website</p>	<p>Touro Law Alumni are welcome to study for the 2017 bar in the library, and may stay for extended hours that are offered to current Touro Law Center students. Touro Law Center ID is required.</p> <p>Students from other law schools, who have graduated in 2017, and who are taking a bar review course at Touro Law Center will be permitted to use the library, beginning May 21, 2017. Students must follow all rules of the library and the school and are considered to be visitors of the school. They are welcome to stay during regular library hours, which are listed below. They may not stay for extended or study hall hours. They must have their student ID and proof of enrollment in the bar study course with them at all times. Wireless access is available. Computer lab and study rooms are for Touro Law Center Students only.</p> <p>Snacks and drinks with lids are permitted. Cell phone conversations are not permitted. Meals are not permitted. Any violation of the noise or food policy will result in library access being revoked.</p> <p><a href="#">Library Hours</a> are subject to change, so please check our website to be certain of hours.
